### VINTAGE

Marked contrasts in weather: an exceptionally wet winter and spring followed by a very hot, dry summer.

Early harvest with increased vigilance.

The wines display a fine balance between freshness and aromatic expression.

### TASTING NOTES

Bright peach hue.

Intense nose with notes of citrus, melon and broom flower.

Well-structured palate with aromas of yellow fruit and citrus.

A deliciously zesty finish with real definition.

### TERROIR

The ninety hectares of vineyards are split between the AOC's eight communes and planted on marl and limestone soils that are particularly well suited to Mourvèdre. They are composed of two main climates.

The grapes grown in the valley offer fresher lighter juice whereas those grown at higher altitudes on the terraced hillsides produce wines with more body and structure.
